The Tax Ombud Judge Bernard Makgabo Ngoepe hereby invites suitable candidates to apply for the independent Governance Committee Members (X3) positions. The appointment is for three (3) years but may be subject to renewal at the discretion of the Tax Ombud.

Remuneration will be paid following Treasury Regulations.

Key outputs

This Committee will function as an oversight and advisory Committee to the Tax Ombud, Judge Bernard Makgabo Ngoepe, in terms of the King IV requirements. The key outputs of the Governance Committee must, amongst others, review the following:

- 1. The Committee shall oversee performance information reporting, internal controls, and fraud risks.
- 2. The Committee shall oversee the implementation of a combined assurance from all the assurance providers in relation to the performance information and related internal controls.
- 3. The Committee shall review and comment on all statutory reporting, including the quarterly and annual performance information against predetermined objectives before submission to the Tax Ombud, focusing mainly on:-

a. any changes in policies and practices;

- b. significant adjustments resulting from the audit;
- c. compliance with applicable laws and regulations; and
- reliability and accuracy of the performance information against predetermined objectives provided by management to other information users.

Requirements

- 1. Twenty (20) years of experience in the following fields: Taxation, Corporate Governance, Risk management, Legal services, Public and Business administration, and Complaints Resolution.
- 2. Ten (10) years of experience serving on Governance Committees or similar committees.
- 3. Applicants should have a relevant degree or equivalent qualification at NQF level nine (9).
- 4. Registration with recognised bodies such as SAICA, ACCA, IIRMS, IoDSA etc., will be an added advantage.
- 5. In addition to the above, preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate experience in participating in governance structures, the ability to dedicate time to the activities of the Governance Committees, and experience in serving on similar committees.

The closing date for the applications is **29 July 2022**, and no late applications will be accepted.
